

Restrictions on Entry / Quarantine Regulations

Due to the Covid 19 pandemic, Germany and Austria have travel restrictions on entry from many countries. Within Germany, for example, special travel regulations apply to residents from districts with more than 50 new infections per 100,000 inhabitants within seven days.

If travel restrictions or regulations apply to you, it is not possible to stay overnight at SMARTments business **except:**

The prerequisite for this is that the medical health certificate confirms a negative PCR test and that the test was carried out no more than 72 hours ago.
